



FLEET ROLES

Workshops;

Vehicle Mechanic (REME VM – RAF/RN VT Class 2 and above)

- To commission, service and maintain all Trust vehicle assets and associated equipment. To de-commission Trust Assets at end of life. Some support mobile work to be undertaken.

Storeman (All Arms/Trades Class 2 and above)

- To support the Workshops in respect of vehicle parts and specialist tooling. Accounting of spend and keeping stock levels to required scale.

Clinical Engineering;

Electronics Technician (REME Class 1 – RAF/RN Equivalent) -MDSS Preference

- To commission, support and maintain the Trusts Medical Devices and associated equipment. To investigate failures as they occur.

Storeman (All Arms/Trades Class 2 and above)

- To support the CE team in respect of MD parts and specialist tooling. Accounting of spend and keeping stock levels to required scale.

Fleet/Logistics;

Administrators (All Arms - Clerks)

- To administrate the logistical elements of Fleet, from vehicle service booking, to maintaining availability by distribution of Trust assets to sites to meet demand

Fleet Drivers (RLC Drivers - RAF/RN Drivers/clerks)

- To move fleet assets around the trust area, in a safe legal and compliant manner.

Make Ready Operatives

- To ensure that ambulances are cleaned, restocked/prepared vehicles for frontline use
